The Rampart Walk in Mary's diaries

March 5, 1895: 'We took our "rampart walk" in spite of the snow.'

Oct. 21, 1895: 'We took Placci on our rampart walk ...'

Oct. 23, 1895: 'I took the rampart walk, in the rain.'

Jan. 26, 1897: 'I printed Bernhard's manuscript and enjoyed that, and after the "rampart" walk I called on the Jeffreasons.'

Apr. 20, 1897: 'Then I took the rampart walk with Blaydes ...'

Nov. 3, 1897: 'Took the rampart walk rather late.'

Dec. 16, 1898: 'We had a most divine walk — an old Fiesole "rampart walk".'
